All playoff rounds are the first team to reach 13 points will advance to the next round  
 The team with the highest season point total has choice of home or away for the first playoff match.  
 Players must have identification on them. You may be required to prove who you are. If you can't produce an I.D. you may not be able to play.

States: (North vs. Boston) (South vs. Central)  
 Semi-State Final: January 16 & 18  
 State Final: January 23 & 25

To break a tie: (for regular season to determine placement)  
 1. \*Adjusted Win & Loss record within division.  
 Each team will receive 1 point per win and .5 point per tie  
 Total points win  
 2. Win & Loss record against each other (total points).  
 3. Add the points of the weeks won only.  
 4. Playoff. -- If necessary will be played on Dec 7th

In the event that a match is tied 6 to 6  
 A tie breaker round must be played:  
 1. (1) game of 501 doubles DJ/DD (1 pt to the winner)  
 2. (1) game of Cricket doubles (1 pt to the winner)  
 If necessary,  
 (1) game of 301 singles DJ/DD (2 out of 3) (1 pt to the winner)
